Past Experience: Successfully Initiated a Senior Executives Club within PCCI (Pietermaritzburg Chamber of Commerce and Industry)

Structure: Formatted as a Chamber, as in the name, to enable future alignment with (complementary to) the International Chamber movement following on from successful establishment of pilot bodies. Noted that the membership is drawn from people from differing backgrounds, not just business.
